

Service Hour Policy St. Louis Catholic School 2010-2011

Junior High students will perform at least 10 service hours to the church, school, community or individuals in need. **These hours must be before or after school hours. All of the hours must be supervised and certified by an adult. The service hours should not be for a relative or a for-profit business.** Extra hours from the 7th grade will not carry over to the 8th grade. 7th grade begins upon promotion to the 7th grade. 8th grade begins upon promotion to the 8th grade.

Forms will be provided by the religion teacher and Director of Religious Education. **The students are responsible for having the form filled out by the adult supervisor of their activity and turning it in to their religion teacher.** The Religion teacher will collect and record hours of students.

Important: Those students who fail to accumulate 10 hours **will have their Religion grade for the year taken down to the highest percentage of the next lower letter grade.** For example, if the year's average is 98 (A), the average would be taken down to 92 (B). (A= 93-100; B=85-92; C=77-84; D=70-76; F=69 and below)

Suggestions for service hours:

-Volunteer to work at the Mission Waco Homeless breakfasts with the St. Louis Social committee on the fifth Fridays of the month. (6-7:45 a.m.)

-Volunteer to help with Vacation Bible School at St. Louis or other church events

-Help with St. Louis Parent's Association events: School Carnival

- School improvement projects

-Wrapping gifts for St. Louis Social Committee's Christmas gift-giving project

-Making and delivering Easter baskets to needy with St. Louis Social Committee

- Visit or make and deliver cards to nursing home residents

-Volunteer to help with St. Louis CCE program as an aid, nursery helper

-Help with concessions, ticket sales, clean-up at Reicher football games

-Take care of the needs of an elderly neighbor (not a relative) such as yard work, cleaning their house, shopping, making them a meal

-Community services such as Special Olympics, Caritas, Family Abuse Center, fund raisers for research for cures.

-Any other project ideas must have prior approval from the Director of Religious Education.
